Guidelines for MCQ Based Undergraduate 6th Semester Online Examination-2021:

On the examination day the student has to follow the steps given below:

- The student will have to visit the Portal www.jucc.in for downloading of their admit card.
- The student need to create their login Id and Password for appearing in the Examination by using their student id and Registration No as printed on Admit Card. Link for creation of Login Id and Password shall be live on or after 11th Sept 2021 (1:00 pm onwards).
- The detailed instructions for appearing in the examination shall be displayed on the portal.
- The students have to compulsory fill the attendance form and then attempt the question paper.
- The response form shall not be accepted after the stipulated time. The Candidate shall be entirely responsible for the timely submission of his/her response and the University Authorities shall not be responsible for any issue regarding non submission of the same.
- The question paper will comprise of the following:
 - Where the Maximum Marks 80 printed on the Syllabus:
 - MCQ = 40
 - Marks = 2 (per MCQ)
 - Attempt = 30 MCQ out of 40
 - Maximum Marks= 60
 - Time = 60 Minutes
 - Where the Maximum Marks 40 printed on the Syllabus:
 - MCQ = 20
 - Marks = 2 (per MCQ)
 - Attempt = 15 MCQ out of 20
 - Maximum Marks= 30
 - Time = 30 Minutes
