Advanced Financial Accounting (BCG-201)**20 Marks**

1. A consignor sent goods costing ₹50,000 to a consignee to be sold on consignment. The consignor paid ₹3,000 for packing and freight. The consignee incurred ₹2,000 for unloading charges and ₹1,000 for advertising. The consignee sold 80% of the goods for ₹60,000 and is entitled to a commission of 5% on total sales.

Required:

- Prepare the Consignment Account in the books of the consignor.
 - Prepare the Consignee's Account in the books of the consignor.
 - Calculate the profit or loss on consignment.
 - Determine the value of closing stock on consignment.
